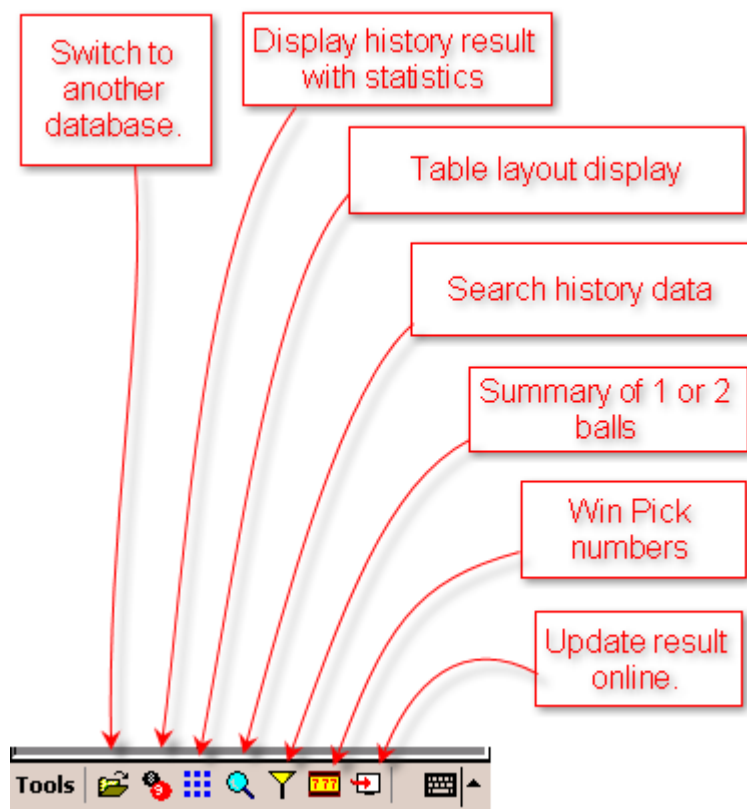

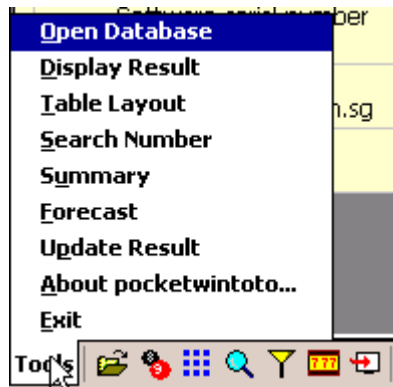
At the bottom of the window is a "Tools" bar with various icons for file operations, search, and system functions.

Below will shows you the function of the icons.

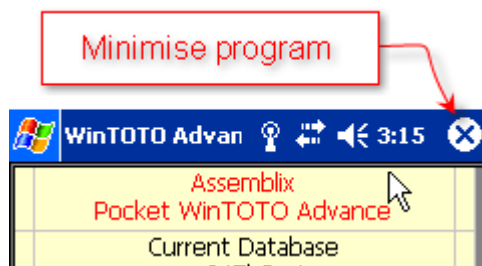


Another way to start the function is by clicking the “Tools” and follow by the appropriate menu items.

If you do not want to exit the program, click the “X” icon on the top right corner. This will only minimize the view, the program is still occupying in the main memory.

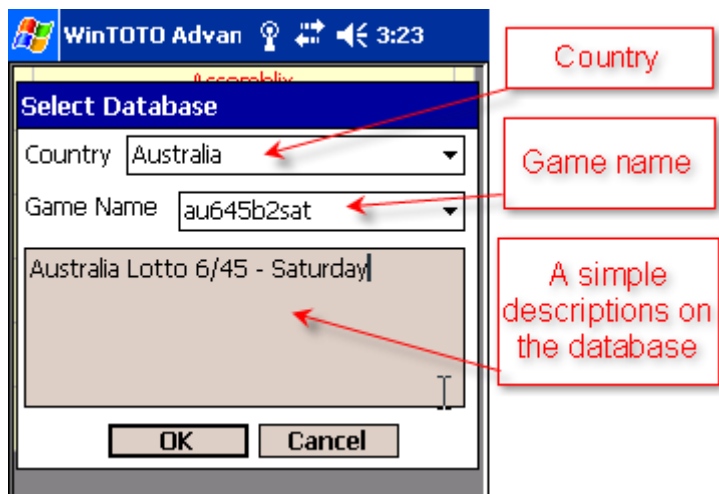


Database

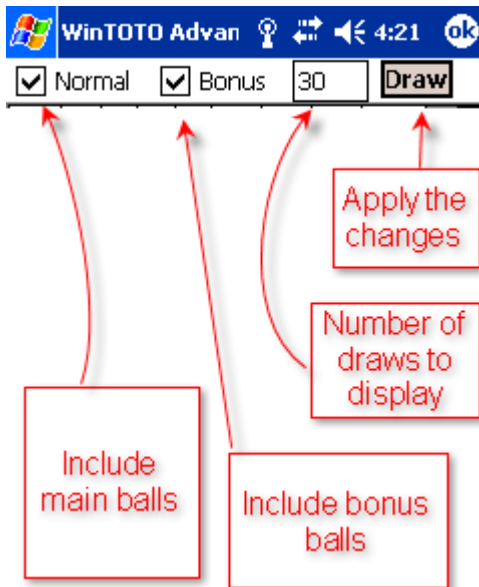


Result Display

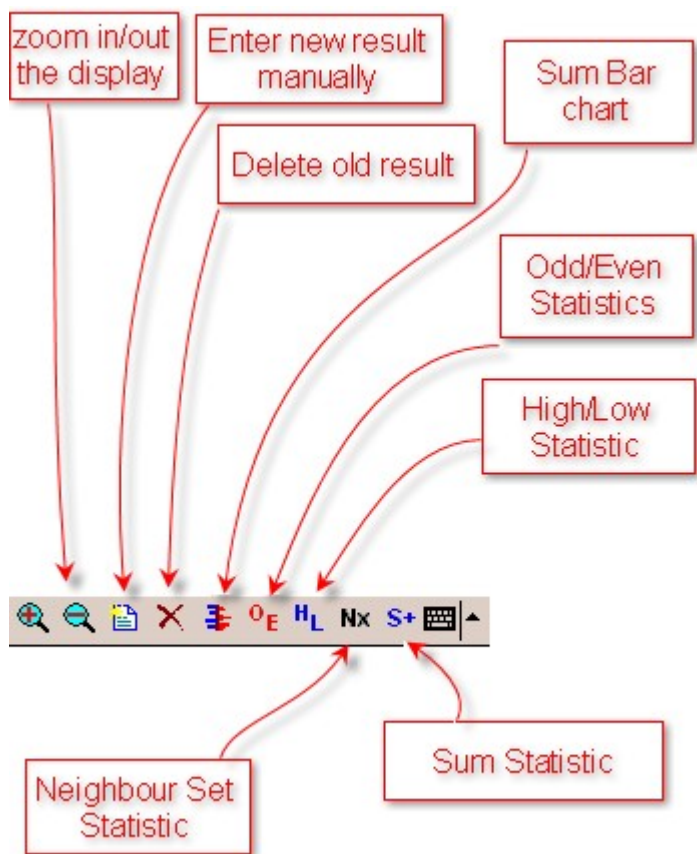
Result are display in rows from top to bottom. The latest result is always at the last line. Below are the definitions of the columns.

The option on the top is to allow you to controls your display and statistic setting. The default is set to 30 draws range. You can change to any numbers of draw. Please take note that Pocket PC has memory limitation. If you set to too many draws, it may exhausted your device memory and hang the whole device.



Within this display result, you will notice a lot of icons below. There are various statistic features there. Their function are shown below.

Enter new result

Entering result manually require a lot of self checking. When you click this button, a dialog box will appear as shown below.

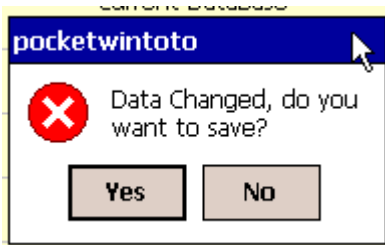
You must enter all the cells with value. Just double click on the cell to enter the data.

The program will estimate the next draw reference from your data. You are to check this and correct it if it is not correct. Just double click on the green cell to enter the data. For date entry, please make sure you key in Year-Month-Day. For number entry, please key in numbers within the game ball sizes.

Once you finish entering the data, you can click the OK button to save it. It will temporary save this data until you exit the display function. Any modification to the display result will pop up a final message to confirm your changes.



Delete Result

You must select which result first before you click this button. You can also make multiple selection to delete multiple result.

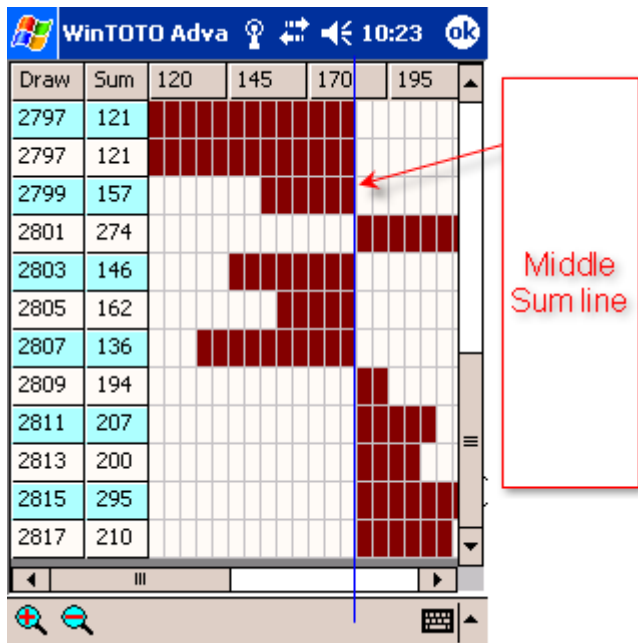

Make sure you double check the record number is the correct record that you have highlighted and follow by the “Yes”


Sum Bar Chart

This is a up/down chart. The center is the middle sum value. If the sum is lesser than the mid sum, than it will be drawn from the lower to the mid sum. If the sum is bigger than the mid sum, than it will draw from the mid sum. You should observe the up or down of this chart to guess the next sum direction. Each segment of cell is representing 5 points. The column shown with value is the starting Sum value for the column.



Odd / Even Statistic

This is a hit statistic table. It will display the number of hits and the percentage of each pair. With this, you can see which pair is the best to play.

High / Low Statistic

This is a hit statistic table. It will display the number of hits and the percentage of each pair. With this, you can see which pair is the best to play. High numbers are number from the middle to the highest ball. Low numbers are number from smallest ball to 1 ball lesser than the middle. Therefore, the high statistic will be more


than the low statistic if the game ball size is odd size. For example, if the game ball size is 45 balls, than the low value is from 1 to 22, the high value is from 23 to 45. The low has 22 balls while the high has 23 balls.

Neighbor Set Statistic

This is a hit statistic table. It will display the number of hits and the percentage of each group from N1-N2-N3. With this, you can see which pair is the best to play. Because of the complexity of the grouping, the program will only tabulate those groups than hit in the displayed history result.

Neighbor sets N! is referring to neighboring numbers such as 1 and 2, 2 and 3, etc. Neighboring sets N2 is referring to 1,2 and 3 or 5,6 and 7, etc. Neighboring sets N3 is referring to 1,2,3 and 4 or 5,6,7 and 8, etc. These 3 sets of grouping will give us some insight on our investment.

Table Display Layout

The numbers are tabulated from smallest to biggest ball value. The highlighted cell is the winning number. With each draw, the cells are highlighted, you can see a certain hit pattern from the highlighted cells. The orange color is for main numbers while the cyan color is referring to bonus number.

The blank cells are label with the running faint color numbers so that we can see the numbers of blank has lapsed.

You can change the number of draw to display but please take note of your device memory limitation. The more draw is display, the more memory it takes. If the program freeze while generating the display, it means the memory is out.

Search

This is an advance search engine. You can search any combination of numbers against the winning history. Each search numbers must be separated by a comma. For example, 5,12,15,26,40,45.

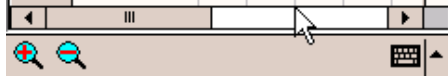
In the option, you can include or exclude normal or bonus ball. The Match option is the number of ball match that is regard as a hit. For example, you can search 6 numbers and you set the number of match to 3 then as long as 3 of them is matched, it is regarded as a hit.

The “Item” column is referring the number of hits. The “Date” is the actual drawn date that matches the winning. All the # columns are the main numbers. Those highlighted in red is the matched numbers. The “+” column is the bonus number.

The additional columns are the statistic of the winning. “Gap” is the number of draw lapse between each hit. This information is very important. With this, you can estimate the similar trend hit.


“AvgGap” is the running average gap calculated base on simple average.

Sum is the sum of all the balls.

Win column will shows the number ball of win.

Summary

This function require a lot of processing power. We manage to include 1 and 2 balls summary.

System 1 Ball is the tabulation of frequency hit and the next gap statistic. "Freq" column is the number of hits since the start of this database. "NGap" is the next gap of the number. When the NGap is 1, it means the next draw lapse is 1 draw since the last hit.

System 2 Ball will be a combination of 2 balls. Depending on the game size, the program will generate all the possible combinations. So please make sure your device has sufficient memory when running System 2 balls.
